



In 1624 a hunting lodge was built on this site in Versailles, France. Then, under King Louis XIV (14th) rebuilt and vastly enlarged the complex.

On June 28, 1919, the Versailles Treaty was signed at the conclusion of World War I.


3 story building with 60 rooms - private residence for the Prime Minister on the 3rd floor.















Leaning © Tower of Pisa

Tower began to lean shortly after construction began in 1173.








America's first Skyscraper: The Wainwright Building

- Located in downtownSt. Louis, Mo.






Art Deco skyscraper
