

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



The Lord does not condemn honest and wise business practices. Rather, he condemns dishonesty in business dealings, specifically as a sign of the self-serving, luxury loving attitude that rules the heart of the greedy at the expense of the needy.


^{AMOS 8:4} Hear this, you who trample the needy and do away with the poor of the land ⁵ saying,

"When will the New Moon be over that we may sell grain, and the Sabbath be ended that we may market wheat?"-skimping the measure, boosting the price and cheating with dishonest scales,

 ⁶ buying the poor with silver and the needy for a pair of sandals, selling even the sweepings with the wheat.

PSALM

SECOND LESSON 1 Timothy 2:1-8

Focus shifts from payment received to payment made, namely, Jesus who generously used his own blood to buy sinners back. As a result, we pray, not for booming economies, but for peace to proclaim this great salvation.

^{1TIMOTHY 2:1} I urge, then, first of all, that requests, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for everyone--² for kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness. ³This is good, and pleases God our Savior, ⁴ who wants all men to be saved and to come to a knowledge of the truth. ⁵ For there is one God and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus, ⁶ who gave himself as a ransom for all men--the testimony given in its proper time. ⁷ And for this purpose I was appointed a herald and an apostle--I am telling the truth, I am not lying--and a teacher of the true faith to the Gentiles.


⁸ I want men everywhere to lift up holy hands in prayer, without anger or disputing.

GOSPEL ACCLAMATION

After the announcement of the Gospel the congregation responds:



GOSPEL Luke 15:11-32

The last of Jesus' "seeking and finding" parables narrows the scope from 100 sheep and 10 coins to just two sons. Both sons displayed greed while the father showed his generosity. Praise be to God that He IS that generous Father!

^{LUKE 16: 11} Jesus continued: "There was a man who had two sons. ¹² The younger one said to his father, 'Father, give me my share of the estate.' So he divided his property between them.

¹³ "Not long after that, the younger son got together all he had, set off for a distant country and there squandered his wealth in wild living. ¹⁴ After he had spent everything, there was a severe famine in that whole country, and he began to be in need. ¹⁵ So he went and hired himself out to a citizen of that country, who sent him to his fields to feed pigs. ¹⁶ He longed to fill his stomach with the pods that the pigs were eating, but no one gave him anything.

¹⁷ "When he came to his senses, he said, 'How many of my father's hired men have food to spare, and here I am starving to death! ¹⁸ I will set out and go back to my father and say to him: Father, I have sinned against heaven and against you. ¹⁹ I am no longer worthy to be called your son; make me like one of your hired men.' ²⁰ So he got up and went to his father.

"But while he was still a long way off, his father saw him and was filled with compassion for him; he ran to his son, threw his arms around him and kissed him.

²¹ "The son said to him, 'Father, I have sinned against heaven and against you. I am no longer worthy to be called your son.' ²² "But the father said to his servants, 'Quick! Bring the best robe and put it on him. Put a ring on his finger and sandals on his feet. ²³ Bring the fattened calf and kill it. Let's have a feast and celebrate. ²⁴ For this son of mine was dead and is alive again; he was lost and is found.' So they began to celebrate.

²⁵ "Meanwhile, the older son was in the field. When he came near the house, he heard music and dancing. ²⁶ So he called one of the servants and asked him what was going on. ²⁷ 'Your brother has come,' he replied, 'and your father has killed the fattened calf because he has him back safe and sound.'

²⁸ "The older brother became angry and refused to go in. So his father went out and pleaded with him. ²⁹ But he answered his father, 'Look! All these years I've been slaving for you and never disobeyed your orders. Yet you never gave me even a young goat so I could celebrate with my friends. ³⁰ But when this son of yours who has squandered your property with prostitutes comes home, you kill the fattened calf for him!'

³¹ " 'My son,' the father said, 'you are always with me, and everything I have is yours. ³² But we had to celebrate and be glad, because this brother of yours was dead and is alive again; he was lost and is found.' "



WORDS OF INSTITUTION



M The peace of the Lord be with you always.




O CHRIST, LAMB OF GOD (Agnus Dei)




PRAYER AND BLESSING


