

Bible Study Skills: Using Context

- **Frank travels a lot.**
 - **Goes to many distant places?**
 - **Takes too many steps without dribbling?**
- **What is needed for meaning?**
 - **Rest of the conversation – Context**
 - **“She couldn’t find the bow.”**
 - **“I’d like to”**
- **AIM: Learn to use context in God’s Word to discover meaning.**

Bible Study Skills: Using Context

- **He replied, “I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven” (Luke 10:18).**
- **What good is it brothers, if a man claims to have faith but has no deeds? Can such a faith save him (James 2:14)?**
- **“Do not handle! Do not taste! Do not touch” (Colossians 2:21)!**

Bible Study Skills: Using Context

- **He replied, “I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven” (Luke 10:18).**
 - **Who is talking? (v. 17)**
 - **Who are the 72? (v. 1)**
 - **What are they talking about (v. 17)**
 - **Read v. 18 – 20.**
- **When and how did Satan fall?**
 - **When demons were cast out**

Bible Study Skills: Using Context

- **What good is it brothers, if a man claims to have faith but has no deeds? Can such a faith save him (James 2:14)?**
 - **Sola Fides? (by faith alone)**
 - **What kind of faith? (v. 17)**
 - **How is “Good!” meant? (v. 19)**
- **What does the passage mean?**
 - **A dead faith will not save.**

Bible Study Skills: Using Context

- **“Do not handle! Do not taste! Do not touch” (Colossians 2:21)!**
 - **Misapplying a passage**
 - **Read Colossians 2:20-23**
 - **Whose rules are they? (v. 20)**
 - **What does “It” refer to?**
 - **Does Paul agree with these rules? (v. 22-23)**
- **Apply the passage correctly**

Bible Study Skills: Using Context

- **POINT 1:**

- **Use the context to find the meaning of short statements in Scripture.**



Bible Study Skills: Using Context

- **Context is more than a particular statement.**

“That pizza was great. I loved the cheeses. Mars is uninhabited, and the crust was fantastic!”

- **Context also involves a line of thought.**

Bible Study Skills: Using Context

- **Philippians 1:12-18**
 - **Paul wants us to know how what happened to him help spread the Gospel.**
 - **What happened to Paul?**
 - **How did it help spread the Gospel?**
 - **By thinking each verse through in context we follow the line of thought and can apply it to ourselves.**
