VISITING PASTOR INTERVIEW

Meet Pastor David Strucely

Throughout this fiftieth anniversary year of Calvary Lutheran School, we will be joined by guest pastors, all of whom are Calvary alumni! What a blessing to witness the impact of Christian education! We look forward to hearing the Word preached by Pastor David Strucely on December 10th and 11th.

MEET PASTOR DAVID STRUCELY

Pastor David Strucely was born in Dallas in 1989. At not even four years old, he was part of the welcoming committee for Pastor Koelpin when he arrived in 1993.

Pastor Strucely attended Calvary Lutheran School from 1993-2004. Many of Calvary's current teachers were his teachers too—Mr. & Mrs. Henrickson, Ms. Aswege, and Ms. Fritz. He also learned from Mrs. Hengst, Mrs. Ihms, and Mrs. Jungemann.

He then attended Luther Preparatory School (2004-2008). In 2007, his parents made the heart-wrenching decision (for Pastor Strucely) to move from Dallas to Wisconsin. He also attended Martin Luther College (2008-2012), and Wisconsin Lutheran Seminary (2014-2018). From 2012 to 2014, Pastor Strucely worked as an English teacher in Carmen de la Legua (Reynoso), Callao, Peru. He also helped the church there during his time.

In 2018, Pastor Strucely was assigned to Atonement in Plano, TX. That same year, he married Katelyn Hansen, and one year later they welcomed their firstborn, a son named Nicholas. In 2021, they welcomed their little girl named Ava. Perhaps, you will see Nicholas and Ava in the halls of Calvary Lutheran School one day.
