


THE WORD

FIRST LESSON Exodus 20:1-6

God commands that his people worship no other god or thing beside Him.

EXODUS 20:1 And God spoke all these words:

- ² "I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of Egypt, out of the land of slavery.
 - ³ "You shall have no other gods before me.
- ⁴ "You shall not make for yourself an idol in the form of anything in heaven above or on the earth beneath or in the waters below. ⁵ You shall not bow down to them or worship them; for I, the LORD your God, am a jealous God, punishing the children for the sin of the fathers to the third and fourth generation of those who hate me, ⁶ but showing love to a thousand generations of those who love me and keep my commandments.

SECOND LESSON Romans 1:18-22

God's wrath comes upon men for exchanging the true God for gods of their own making.

ROMANS 1:18 The wrath of God is being revealed from heaven against all the godlessness and wickedness of men who suppress the truth by their wickedness, ¹⁹ since what may be known about God is plain to them, because God has made it plain to them. ²⁰ For since the creation of the world God's invisible qualities--his eternal power and divine nature--have been clearly seen, being understood from what has been made, so that men are without excuse.

Alleluia. Jesus replied: Love your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind. Alleluia (Matthew 22:37)

GOSPEL Matthew 19:16-26

Jesus reveals to a rich young man that his wealth had become his god.

 $^{\rm MATTHEW\,19:16}$ Now a man came up to Jesus and asked, "Teacher, what good thing must I do to get eternal life?"

¹⁷ "Why do you ask me about what is good?" Jesus replied. "There is only One who is good. If you want to enter life, obey the commandments."


¹⁸ "Which ones?" the man inquired.

Jesus replied, "'Do not murder, do not commit adultery, do not steal, do not give false testimony, ¹⁹ honor your father and mother,' and 'love your neighbor as yourself.'"

- ²⁰ "All these I have kept," the young man said. "What do I still lack?"
- ²¹ Jesus answered, "If you want to be perfect, go, sell your possessions and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven. Then come, follow me."
 - ²² When the young man heard this, he went away sad, because he had great wealth.
- ²³ Then Jesus said to his disciples, "I tell you the truth, it is hard for a rich man to enter the kingdom of heaven. ²⁴ Again I tell you, it is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for a rich man to enter the kingdom of God."
- ²⁵ When the disciples heard this, they were greatly astonished and asked, "Who then can be saved?"
- ²⁶Jesus looked at them and said, "With man this is impossible, but with God all things are possible."

M Brothers and sisters, go in peace. Live in harmony with one another. Serve the Lord with gladness.


